From Moonshine to Finish Line: Corvette Museum Showcases History of NASCAR with New Exhibit

Well before modified race cars plastered with sponsor logos took to oval tracks across the country, small, fast stock cars could be seen speeding around the Appalachian region carrying bootleg whiskey, attempting to evade police. Drivers would modify their cars to make them quick and nimble, maximizing speed as well as space to carry their precious cargo. The sport of "runnin' shine" eventually evolved and the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) was officially founded in 1948 by Bill France, Sr. Today the sport is second to the NFL among professional sports franchises when it comes to television ratings in the United States.

The National Corvette Museum's Exhibit Hall is hosting a special exhibit to pay homage to the sport, from its early roots of moonshine running, to today's multi-billion dollar industry. The exhibit includes 14 cars from a 1940s Moonshine runner, to recent race winners. The line-up includes: #3 - Dale Earnhardt Wheaties Chevrolet 1997 Monte Carlo; #3 - Junior Johnson 1963 Chevrolet Impala SS; #6 - Mark Martin 1994 Valvoline Ford; #8 Dale Earnhardt Jr. Budweiser Chevrolet Monte Carlo SS; #16 - Greg Biffle 2013 3M (1,000th NASCAR win for Ford); #17 - Darrell Waltrip Tide 1987 Monte Carlo; #24 - Jeff Gordon DuPont Fire & Flames Design, 2005 Monte Carlo; #27 - 1953 Corvette NASCAR; #43 - Richard Petty 1986/87 Pontiac Aero; #48 - Jimmie Johnson Lowe's Power of Pride Design 2003 Monte Carlo; #72 - Benny Parsons 1973 Chevelle, Winston Cup Winner; #88 – Dale Earnhardt, Jr. 2008 Impala SS; and #97 - Kurt Busch 2004 Nextel Championship Winning Taurus.

The special exhibit opened Friday, May 15 and runs through Sunday, September 6. It is included with regular Museum admission. To learn more about each car and see photos, visit www.nascarexhibit.org.



Corvette Racing, Corvette DP at Laguna Seca: Overall Win for Westbrook, Valiante

VisitFlorida.com Racing Corvette DP narrowly edges out Wayne Taylor Racing in thrilling finish

- Third Laguna Seca win for No. 90 Corvette Daytona Prototype
- Chevrolet extends Prototype Engine Manufacturer championship lead
- Milner, Gavin lead Corvette Racing GTLM effort with sixth-place finish

MONTEREY, Calif. - Richard Westbrook and Michael Valiante gave the Corvette Daytona Prototype its third straight victory in the TUDOR United SportsCar Championship on Sunday. The pairing won the Continental Tire Monterey Grand Prix at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca in their VisitFlorida.com Racing No. 90 Corvette DP. Corvette Daytona Prototypes took four of the top five positions in the fourth race of the season. Sunday's result increased Chevrolet's lead in the Prototype Engine Manufacturer championship, and it vaulted Westbrook and Valiante into the lead of the Prototype Driver's standings.

Westbrook finished 1.351 seconds ahead of Ricky Taylor in Wayne Taylor Racing's No. 10 Konica Minolta Corvette DP. Taylor and brother Jordan now have a victory and two runner-up finishes in their last three races.

"It was an excellent battle between Richard Westbrook and Ricky Taylor to the finish today at Laguna Seca," said Jim Lutz, Chevrolet Program Manager for Corvette Daytona Prototypes. "Richard and Michael Valiante drove well, and the quick work by

the VisitFlorida.com Racing crew helped secure today's win. Our Corvette DP program is carrying great momentum heading to our 'home race' in Detroit later this month."

Valiante led the first 15 laps, and Westbrook led the final 29. The key moment came on his final pit stop with 29 minutes left when he took a quick splash of fuel without giving up the lead. Westbrook won for the second time at Laguna Seca. He and Valiante also won last year at Watkins Glen International.

The Wayne Taylor Corvette DP led three times in the race for 70 laps. Jordan Taylor started the race from pole position.

Action Express Racing's two Corvette DPs were fourth and fifth. Joao Barbosa and Christian Fittipaldi in the No. 5 Mustang Sampling Corvette DP finished just ahead of Eric Curran and Dane Cameron in the No. 31 Whelen Engineering/Team Fox Corvette DP.

In GT Le Mans, Corvette Racing's two Chevrolet Corvette C7.Rs finished sixth and seventh in class. Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner in the No. 4 Corvette posted their best finish since a third-place result to start 2015 at Daytona. Milner qualified fifth but was balked at the start and had to cede two positions. Gavin drove the final 57 minutes and suffered a minor hit by a Prototype Challenge car but otherwise had an uneventful stint.

Two-time and defending Laguna Seca class winners Antonio Garcia and Jan Magnussen found frustration early and often in their race. Garcia started near the rear of the field after an overnight engine change but quickly moved through the slower GT Daytona field. Unfortunately he suffered right-front body damage as two prototypes worked their way through in a battle for the overall lead.

The next race for the Corvette Daytona Prototypes is the Chevrolet Sports Car Classic from Belle Isle Raceway in Detroit on Saturday, May 30.

Corvette Racing next heads across the Atlantic Ocean to the 24 Hours of Le Mans on June 13-14.
